



CSL Grants

Application Details

A complete grant application is to include the following:

- An online application submitted through the portal.
- A signed letter on the organisation's letterhead requesting the Grant, including dates of the Program, any partners in execution of the Program and amount requested.
- An agenda and/or brochure for the program.
- Using the required CSL template, complete all necessary fields including Estimated Income at the top of the sheet. For ease of review of Grant components, add additional sheets if request includes more than one Program Method. Include Descriptions to provide further information.
- Download Budget Template
- Documentation regarding the purpose and outcome of the program.
- Documentation of the hosting institution's accreditation as a CME provider (i.e., accreditation certificate), if applicable.
- Documentation of a government issued tax document containing Tax Identification Number (TIN).

Application Request Process

Review "Areas of Interest" on [CSL Vifor UK](#) to identify if the grant request aligns with CSL areas of interest.

Review "Application Details" section above, regularly for changes to the requirements to ensure the request meets all current program requirements.

- Your request will be reviewed and we will notify you via email of the decision.
- If your request is approved, you will be contacted regarding the Agreement and disbursement process
